Examples of our work

- Representing an HGV driver charged with Causing Death by Dangerous Driving following his failure to react to stationary traffic on a motorway. Successfully defended the driver identifying evidence that the driver had suffered a serious of "microsleeps" as a result of an undiagnosed sleep apnoea condition. The Prosecution offered no evidence and the case attracted much media attention and calls for change to the way in which HGV driver medical examinations are conducted.
- Representing a driver charged with two counts of Causing Death by Dangerous Driving following his causing fatal injuries to two pedestrians. The driver had no memory due to suffering a head injury. There were no eye witness accounts. The Prosecution alleged that the driver had lost control due to speed.

- DWF's Criminal Defence Team obtained key expert evidence which indicated that the manner in which control had been lost had to have been in reaction to an emergency situation and after a Trial the Defendant was acquitted.
- Representing an HGV driver charged with Wanton and Furious Driving following his colliding with an employee at a warehouse to which he was delivering. The driver accessed the premises in contravention of a one-way system. The Police led the enquiry which resulted in a prosecution for this offence because the incident had occurred on private land. The driver was acquitted and retained his licence following our successful submissions.

Early intervention

Early intervention is the key and the team understands the importance of accessing information and evidence at the outset so that an accurate assessment (as to criminal and civil liability and quantum aspects) can be made early on in the proceedings.
