Dr Mark Alexander-Williams is a Consultant in Pain Management and an Expert Witness instructed by Claimants and Defendants.

He has been an expert witness for 10 years and has completed over 1,500 reports. His report writing ratio is balanced and he has opined on both PI and Clinical Negligence reports evenly. He has experience reporting on the TVT mesh cases and has offered opinion on many amputations related claims. His forensic approach means that he is considered a knowledgeable and sensible expert with the wider instructing party community.

Clinical Experience

Dr Mark Alexander-Williams stands at the forefront of private Pain Management consultancy in London. His journey in medicine commenced at The London Hospital, where he also started his anaesthetic training. His professional path led him through roles as an SHO in Bury St Edmunds, followed by a Registrar position in Leicester and within the South Trent rotation.

Taking a hiatus from clinical duties prior to achieving Senior Registrar status, Dr Alexander-Williams delved into research, exploring innovative methods of opiate administration and investigating the impact of anaesthetic agents on respiratory function. During his tenure as a senior registrar, he undertook a sabbatical year in Melbourne, Australia. Later, as a consultant, he devoted six months to refining his skills in intervention pain techniques during a sabbatical in London.

Driven by a passion for tackling complex pain challenges, Dr Alexander-Williams finds himself immersed in diverse cases. A significant portion of his referrals, amounting to three-quarters, relate to back pain and sciatica. He specialises in incorporating invasive methodologies like radiofrequency lesioning within a comprehensive biopsychosocial care model.



Hannah Bashforth Consultant Clinical Psychologist

Dr Hannah Bashforth has worked as a clinical psychologist in psychological medicine and pain services across the North West for over 17 years, including most recently 8 years as research lead at The Walton Centre for Neurology and Neurosurgery and 4 years as lead Clinical Psychologist for psychological trauma (PTSD) in ICU services in a large Manchester NHS Trust.

She is currently Academic Director at the University of Liverpool Clinical Psychology Doctoral programme and is actively involved in research groups in both pain and birth trauma; she is well published in peer reviewed papers and presents regularly at conferences and seminars. Dr Bashforth has held numerous national positions representing psychology in chronic pain, including that of National psychology representative for the British Pain Society. Dr Bashforth has a particular interest in female health related issues and psychological trauma.

In addition to many years working within NHS medical psychology services Dr Bashforth has also been working in private practice since 2009 and commenced medicolegal work in 2012. She completes both personal injury and medical negligence claims for claimant and defence and holds a 50:50 split in work completed.

Brian works for Aviva in their site just outside Glasgow. He has been working in the claims industry for five years and has been part of Aviva's Know Your Opponent team for the past two years.
